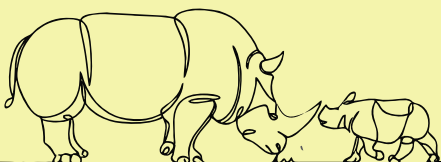


Boarding and Lodging in Jungle Camping Tents Equipped with 4-inch mattress, bedsheets, pillows & quilts provided on proper beds.

Attached Western Washroom with Hot & Cold running water facility



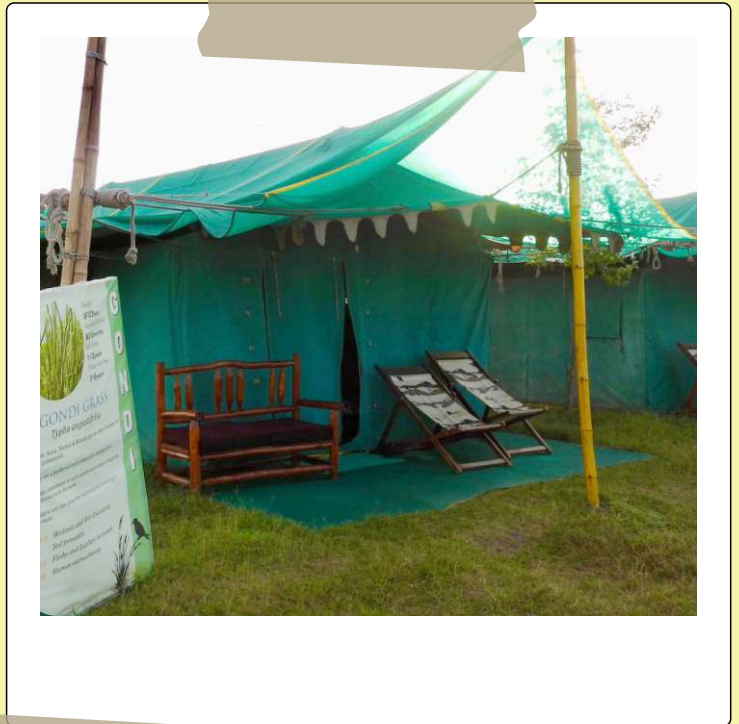
